### Which line do I play or sing?

Left Side Facing Stage (Voice) - If you are seated on the left side of the hall (facing the stage) and don't have an instrument, sing this part on the word "La"

Right Side Facing Stage (Voice) - If you are seated on the right side of the hall (facing the stage) and don't have an instrument, sing this part on the word "La"

Treble Clef Instruments - If you have a treble clef instrument such as violin, flute, recorder, etc., play this line

Alto Clef Instruments - If you have an alto clef instrument such as viola, play this line.

Bass Clef Instruments - If you have a bass clef instrument such as cello, bassoon or bass, play this line
